YEARLY SAFETY INSPECTION: The Catholic Mutual Group is the insurance carrier for the Eparchy and will be conducting an onsite safety inspection at Patronage Church this week on July 14th.

PARISH MAINTENANCE/REPAIRS/IMPROVEMENTS:

1. Two window wells were recently installed on the outside of our church by the sacristy back steps.
2. The Narthex, cry room, elevator area, and the steps going up to the choir loft have been freshly painted.
3. Our semi-annual elevator inspection was completed.
4. The fire suppression system, in the church kitchen, was inspected along with all of our fire extinguishers.
5. Pest control inspections are done monthly on the inside and outside of our church.
6. Our Temple and hall continue to be professionally cleaned each week.
7. A custom cabinet was made to match the vestment cabinet for the Altar Server Sacristy to store altar/church supplies.
8. A new window air conditioning unit was purchased (to replace the old one) for the sacristy. Volunteers are needed to help install it.
